Notice of Public Hearing

NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Cortes Madera Town Council will hold a Public Hearing to review information, receive public comments, and consider

(1) INTRODUCING AN ORDINANCE ESTABLISHING A RESIDENTIAL PARKING PERMIT PROGRAM TO RESTRICT NON-RESIDENTS FROM PARKING ON

RESIDENTIAL STREETS THE TOWN COUNCIL MAY DESIGNATE BY RESOLUTION FROM TIME-TO-TIME, AND (2) ADOPT A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A ONE-YEAR PILOT RESIDENTIAL PERMIT PARKING PROGRAM IN MADERA GARDENS

- The proposed ordinance will restrict non-residential parking on those residential streets the Town Council may designate by resolution from time-to-time in order to reduce use of the designated streets as overflow parking for non-residential uses.
- The proposed resolution will reduce or eliminate the use of the Madera Gardens neighborhood as parking for Redwood High School students and decrease traffic in the neighborhood.
- If both the ordinance and resolution are adopted, Madera Gardens residents may apply for parking permits for cars registered to their home address.

All interested persons are welcome to attend and to comment, in person or in writing, at the public hearing which will be held on Tuesday, August 6, 2019 at 6:30PM at Cortes Madera Town Hall, 300 Tamalpais Drive. 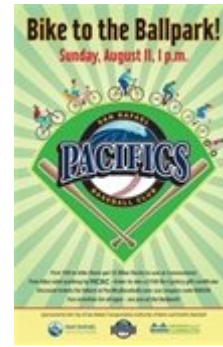

Kent Island

Be a part of the team working to restore the unique ecosystem on Kent Island in Bolinas Lagoon! You'll learn the value of protecting this little oasis, and how to identify and remove the invasive species that threaten it. Participation requires a short rowboat ride to the island. Volunteer work is mildly strenuous and involves bending, pulling, kneeling, and usually requires a short hike to the site.



It is possible for volunteers as young as 5 years old to join if teamed with a parent or guardian. Dress in layers, you can get dirty. Wear sturdy shoes and bring water. Rubber boots are strongly recommended, although not required. Snacks and extra water will be provided but bring a lunch.
