RE: AB 1443 (Melody's Law) – SUPPORT

Dear Senator Leno:

The Town of Corte Maderais pleased to write in support of AB 1443, legislation authored by Assemblymember Huffman regarding repeat DUI offenders that will lead to safer communities.

In May 2009, nine year old Melody Osheroff was killed by a driver with multiple prior DUI convictions. The irresponsible and reckless behavior of repeat offenders, like the man who killed Melody, unfairly place other motorists and pedestrians at risk.

According to the California Department of Motor Vehicles, in 2007 alone there were 2,238 alcohol and drug related traffic fatalities in California – over half of all traffic fatalities reported that year. And, the National Highway Traffic Safety Administration reports more than 310,000 California residents had at least three DUI convictions as of 2008. In that same year, more than 1,000 people were killed in California and another 28,000 were injured as a result of drunken driving. AB 1443, "Melody's Law," will ensure that dangerous drivers are removed from the road before they seriously injure or kill someone.

AB 1443 increases public safety from repeat DUI offenders by permanently revoking a driver's license after three DUI convictions and preventing drivers with revoked licenses from registering their vehicles. The bill allows an offender one opportunity to petition the court to regain their license if stringent requirements are satisfied.

AB 1443 offers a real way to reduce tragedies like those experienced by the Osheroff family and others, and it offers strengthened protections for the citizens we represent.
