

### THE TOWN OF CORTE MADERA GENERAL PLAN DRAFT ENVIRONMENTAL IMPACT REPORT

- LEAD AGENCY:** Town of Corte Madera
- PROJECT TITLE:** The Town of Corte Madera General Plan
- PROJECT LOCATION:** The Town of Corte Madera Planning Area consists of approximately 2,500 acres, or four square miles, plus 400 acres of additional lands outside the Town limits which encompass open space lands within Marin County and waters of the San Francisco Bay. Corte Madera is located in Marin County, approximately nine miles north of San Francisco, with its eastern border on the San Francisco Bay and its western edge bordered by unincorporated Marin County lands. Mount Tamalpais lies immediately west, and adjacent to Corte Madera are the Cities of Larkspur to the north and Mill Valley to the south and the Town of Tiburon to the southeast. Highway 101 bisects the Town.
- PROJECT DESCRIPTION:** The General Plan Update comprises newly proposed goals, policies, and implementation actions which will be used to shape future preservation, enhancement, and development-related decisions. The General Plan Update will allow the community to establish its long-term vision for the future over the next ten to twenty years. Implementation of the policies would be used by the Town to guide decision-making toward attainment of the goals in the Plan. The General Plan includes elements required by state law: Land Use, Circulation, Noise, Open Space, Conservation, and Safety, and may include other topics such as sustainability and community design.
- SIGNIFICANT ENVIRONMENTAL EFFECTS:** The Town has prepared a Draft Environmental Impact Report (EIR) to address the specific environmental effects of implementing the General Plan. The Draft EIR consists of a focused analysis of the following environmental issue areas that may be impacted by the project:
- Land Use
  - Population, Housing, and Employment
  - Biological Resources
  - Cultural and Paleontological

- Hazards/Risk of Upset
- Transportation and Circulation
- Noise
- Air Quality
- Geology and Soils

- Hydrology and Water Quality

Resources

- Visual Resources and Aesthetics
- Public Services
- Cumulative Impacts
- Growth Inducing Impacts
- Significant Irreversible Environmental Changes

Listed hazardous waste sites, hazardous materials users and other associated hazardous material sites (including sites identified under Section 65962.5 of the Government Code) are known to be present in the Town of Corte Madera General Plan Planning Area and are identified in Section 4.3 (Hazards/Risk of Upset) of the Draft EIR.

**PUBLIC REVIEW PERIOD/STATUS:** A **60-day public review period** will be provided to receive written comments on the adequacy of the Draft EIR. The comment period will start on **April 14, 2008** and end on **June 13, 2008**. Written comments should be sent to the following address:
